## OUR OBJECTIVES

- Provide Public Health education globally, who still do not have access to education and awareness necessary to improve their living, via the capacity building of individuals, organisations, and institutions.
- Utilize a 'public health model' of capacity building, with volunteer academic and support staff and Open Educational Resources available through the GCFORCB, using a collaborative approach and modern Information and Communication Technology.
- Offer education at the 'trainers of training' benchmarked to the Master's degree level, for those with prior educational and occupational experience.

- Provide education that meets identified competencies which help with the evidence-based practice of Public Health and are action-oriented, and assist in tackling major health problems facing the population.
- Create an educational portfolio including continuing professional development modules and awards of the certificate, diploma, bachelor, Master of Public Health and Doctorate Programs in India.
- Work with the graduates of the educational program, and other relevant partner organisations, in teaching, research, implementation of evidence-based health policy and advocacy to improve the health of their populations.

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR 2019**

This year we were able to touch 1601 frontline health workers (FLHW) throughout eight districts of Uttar Pradesh. This year too GCFORCB Organisation laid special emphasis on expansion of education amongst Frontline healthcare professionals. Through its two different projects, it stressed that skills can play a significant role in empowering Frontline healthcare professionals and in securing a rightful place for them.

Besides education, empowerment of FLHWs was also attempted through the activities of life-skill workshops, exposure visits, residential workshops, visits to primary health Centres, awareness generation on emergency Skills and etc. Health camps and CHC, PHC, SC, School health visits were provided for their health checkups and treatment of common diseases. Activities of other NGO meeting, stakeholders meeting, and change-makers training were organized to empower FLHW and other community members to seek their involvement in the projects.
