The PGDPHA is a 32-credit program. 24 credits have been distributed over 08 modules, 05 credits have been allotted for the field work, and 3 credits to Internships. The disciplines included in this program focus on management of public health, biostatistics, demography, epidemiology, ethics, health promotion and education, health resources & finance management, health legislation, equity, and the social sciences.

ASSESSMENT

The assessment process is intended to support the learning journey of the Scholars and drive excellence. Assessment of the scholar's learning will be through a combination of

- Class participation
- Graded individual and group assignments
- Quizzes
- Term papers and examinations
- Peer assessment in the collaborative groups
- Assessment by learning mentors (Bricoleurs)
- Field Work and or Project Work

ELIGIBILITY:

The programme is open to anyone who has completed his/her undergraduate/ Postgraduate studies in any discipline. Prior experience is a strong plus, not mandatory. We have noted that students with a strong liberal healthcare background and sound quantitative and analytical skills will be prepared to thrive at UIGH.

PROCESS:

The admissions process at UIGH is a fairly simple one. The application form, which is free of cost, is available on the website/brochure of UIGH/www.gcforgb.org. The form consists of personal information about the applicant along with details of academics. Once the candidate submits the filled form, the application goes through an internal screening process. If shortlisted, the candidate is invited to the UIGH Program campus for a round of Group Discussion and Personal Interview. The candidate is encouraged to take a quantitative capability survey to help him/her understand his/her working level of quantitative skills. Note: This survey has no bearing on the admission decision of a candidate. The scoring is strictly confidential.

ADMISSIONS

We are looking for students with an attitude to learn and a drive to bring about change. They should have demonstrated academic excellence, but more importantly engaged with the community and challenges beyond the classrooms.

We welcome college graduates from India or abroad, with or without prior public health experience or education. There is no age bar; in fact, we prefer graduates who have had prior work experience in any field. So, if you are intellectually curious and socially conscious, we encourage you to apply.

We follow a rolling selection process in three rounds of interviews and group discussions. This means, the earlier you apply, the faster your application is processed for shortlisting, immersion and decision, and higher is the likelihood of securing a spot in the course. Early applicants have the benefit of having more time to take their decisions pertaining to acceptance. They also get the opportunity to be a part of the pre-programme events and activities organized by the institution. Likelihood of financial aid award is higher in the initial round.

For the incoming batch commencing in August 2020, the application forms for admission are now available on the website.

PLACEMENT

Placement Assistance will be given after completion of the training. The key endeavor of Placement Cell at UIGH: Ranchi GCFORCB Org is to facilitate the employability of the students, enrolled for the GCFORCB on-campus programs

The UIGH placement cell supports the placement process by identifying relevant career opportunities for those who are seeking placement assistance.

The placement cell provides timely update to the enrolled candidates about available opportunities in other organizations of relevance.

Every quarterly, the UIGH placement cell also organizes professional development workshop for the enrolled candidates, which includes sessions on resume writing/cover letter writing/ interview skills/ email etiquettes/ group discussion etc. Those interested for the placements are required to attend these workshops and not miss any session.

PLACEMENT POLICY

APPLICABLE FOR EACH COURSE.

The UIGH placement cell will extend full support to students to assist them in the placements, however the placement cell does not guarantee the final placements. The enrolled candidates are required to extend their full support in the entire placement process and work closely with the placement cell for placements.

Any enrolled candidates looking for a region specific opportunity will be required to work closely with the placement cell to identify the opportunity and apply for the same. The UIGH Placement cell will not be responsible for providing region specific opportunities.

The UIGH placement cell will provide information about available opportunities to the candidate. The enrolled candidates seeking placement assistance are expected to apply for the same. However, the final placement of the candidate depends upon the candidate's performance in the entire application and selection process.

All the enrolled candidates are required to attend the pre-placement talk by the potential employers, arranged by the UIGH placement cell.

Once the UIGH placement cell shares the enrolled candidate's profiles with potential employers, details of shortlisting will be communicated to the enrolled candidates. The shortlisted enrolled candidates are required to attend the initial meeting/ interview with the organization, after discussion with the UIGH placement cell.

The enrolled candidates have to be sure about the opportunity before applying for the position/profile shared by the placement cell. Any withdrawal of the candidature at a later stage will result in disqualifying the candidate from further placement process.

An enrolled candidate who has applied for a particular position, and has been shortlisted is required to appear for the interview. Any uninformed absence from the interview, except for some valid reasons, will result in disqualifying the candidate from the placement process.

Once the enrolled candidates appear for the process, and has been selected for the position offered, he/she needs to accept the offer. In the absence of such, the candidate will not be eligible for any subsequent placement from GCFORCB. Such candidates will be considered as "placed" by the placement cell.

Once the candidate has accepted one offer, he/she is not eligible for further placement opportunities through the placement cell.

The candidate is required to accept the offer within nine days of getting the confirmation from the organization, or as per the requirement of the hiring organization. In the absence of which, the UIGH placement cell is free to nominate the next eligible candidate for the offer.

Before accepting the offer, the candidates are advised to fully understand the rules and regulations of hiring organizations, if they are required to submit their original certificates and/or sign any bond or

agreement with the organization. In the absence of which the candidate will themselves be responsible for any consequences and the Institute will not take any responsibility for the same.

The candidates are required to submit a soft copy/photocopy of the offer letter to the UIGH placement cell.

Once a candidate has been selected in an organization with/without support from the placement cell, he/she is required to inform the placement cell regarding the same.
